This series also features our Mini Food Truck Festival with delicious eats - all locally owned businesses and homegrown creativity!

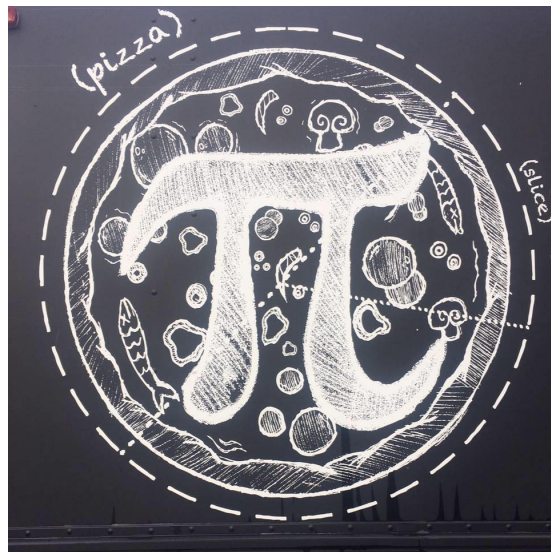
